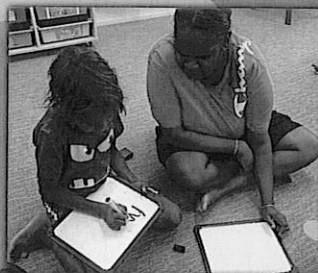


Titjikala School Action Plan
