Privacy Information Statement - Maths Invaders

What is a Privacy Information Statement?

When a digital service or application is utilised as part of the teaching and learning curriculum, we require your consent to allow collection, use and disclosure of your child's personal information including when data is transferred and held in cloud-based storage offshore, outside Australia. The following Privacy Information Statement provides information about the application to allow informed consent to be provided.

What is Maths Invaders?

Maths Invaders is an online learning system that is designed to help students build comprehensive maths processing power, math fact and fluency. Suitable for ages 5 to 15 years and beyond through interactive games and instructions Maths Invaders enables students to build mathematical understanding and confidence.

What data is collected?

Teachers register an account using their name class and school. Each student is linked to the teacher and class account using their name and class and year level.

How is the data used?

Student information collected is used to set up each individual student account linked to the class and school account for use of the service. Any participation in weekly competitions, results are displayed by class not individual students.

Is the data secure?

The Maths Invaders privacy policy state data is kept secure through secure connections and held in encrypted databases. Security and safety of data is driven by USA Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998, COPPA, and the Australian Privacy Principles. Maths Invaders online is KidSafe certified.

Who has access to the data?

School staff mainly teachers who are account administrators and account holders, employees of EdAlive, company of Maths Invaders. The privacy policy states they do not disclose any personal

information to third parties either within Australia or overseas.

When is the data deleted?

Teacher administrators of an account have the ability to edit modify or delete student data as required. Any other concerns relating to the management of personal information can be directed to the EdAlive Privacy Officer via their website.

Where is the data?

Data is hosted outside of the Northern Territory but within Australia via Amazon Web Services.
