

Privacy Information Statement - Inquisitive

What is a Privacy Information Statement?

When a digital service or application is utilised as part of the teaching and learning curriculum, we require your consent to allow collection, use and disclosure of your child's personal information including when data is transferred and held in cloud-based storage offshore, outside Australia. The following Privacy Information Statement provides information about the application to allow informed consent to be provided.

What is Inquisitive?

Inquisitive is an online system that provides teachers and primary schools with high quality lessons, curriculum resources, planning and assessments. Subjects include Geography, History, Science and Technology, English, Maths, Civics and Citizenship, Economics and Business.

What data is collected?

School staff first name, surname and email address is required to register an account, as well as Country/State, role and school name. Personal information for students is not required as students access this system via a class pin or a QR code generated by the teacher. No personal information is collected by the service when students login via a class pin or QR code.

How is the data used?

Data collected is used to provide teachers and primary schools with high quality lessons, curriculum resources, planning and assessments.

Is the data secure?

Inquisitive state in their privacy policy that they handle all personal data in line with the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988.

Who has access to the data?

Teachers, school administrators and leaders will have access to manage student, work, assessments and interactions. The use of student performance will be used to facilitate, direct and review students' work.

Students will have access to lessons and learning content, as well as being able to interact and

collaborate with their teachers and students within their class.

When is the data deleted?

Schools may delete some or all student data manually from the system. Parents who wish to have data of their children or those in care deleted, should request this to the teacher or school. Any personal data will then be deleted within 60 days of a written request to Inquisitive, users will be notified once the information has been deleted.

Inquisitive will automatically delete personal data for users if their account remains unused for 8 years.

Where is the data?

The data is hosted in Amazon Web Services in Sydney, Australia.
