


2024 Action Plan

2. Employ More Yapa Staff

Help yapa staff to work at the school and to participate in training and development opportunities so they are:

Team Teaching with Kardiya

Supporting students with additional needs

Working with families to improve engagement and attendance.

3. Quality Secondary Programs for Students in Years 7 - 12

Employ classroom teachers with experience and expertise in teaching students at the secondary level, including:

Literacy & numeracy

The Arts

STEM

Vocational Education

Physical Education.

4. Explicit teaching & learning of Warlpiri & English language, literacy, and numeracy.

Create another Early Childhood class so students have a better chance to engage and learn
