## Preschool guide to NQF policy requirements

The table below cross-references Department of Education and Training's policies against the requirements for the Education and Care Services National Regulations, specifically regulation 168. Preschools must implement the following policies and procedures in accordance with the <u>Preschool specific policy</u> and ensure they are available for staff and parents at all times (this can be electronically).
