## Certificate III in early childhood education and care (CHC30121)

This nationally accredited qualification is the current industry minimum standard to become a qualified assistant and educator in an early childhood education and care service setting.

- Vacation care service.

## Diploma of early childhood education and care (CHC50121)

This qualification reflects the role of early childhood educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in early childhood education and care services. In doing so they work to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard.

They may have responsibility for the supervision of staff and program delivery.

Employment opportunities include:

- Group leader, coordinator or supervisor in an early childhood education and care service
- Child development worker
- Children's services manager
- Director or manager of an early childhood education and care service
- Entry into Bachelor of Education Early Childhood Teaching (takes one 1 year off degree)
