#### **Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30113)**

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education and care settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's wellbeing, learning and development.

This nationally accredited qualification is the current industry minimum standard to become a qualified assistant and educator in a child care centre.

- Educator in an out of school hours facility
- Educator in a vacation care facility

This qualification reflects the role of early childhood educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in early childhood education and care services. In doing so they work to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard.

They may have responsibility for supervision of volunteers or other staff.

- Child Development Worker
- Children's Services Manager
- Centre Coordinator/Supervisor
- Centre Director/Manager
- Compliance Officer – Quality Education and Care NT
- Entry into Bachelor of Education Early Childhood Teaching (takes one 1 year off degree)
