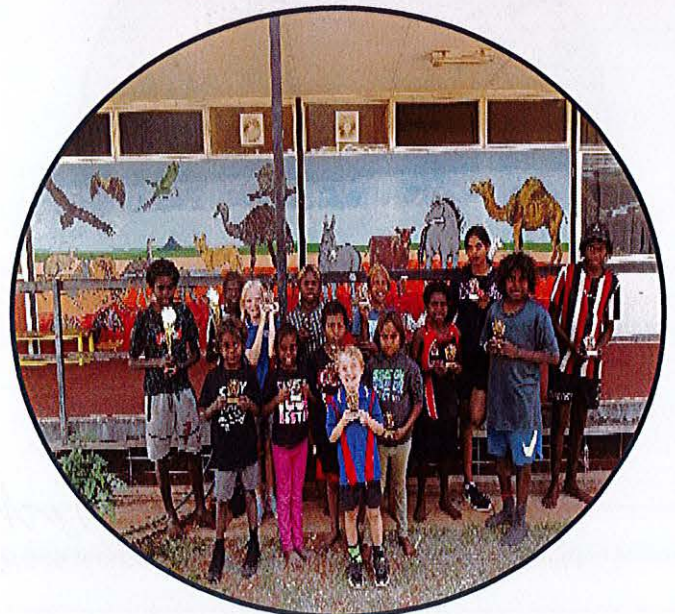

### Wellbeing and inclusion

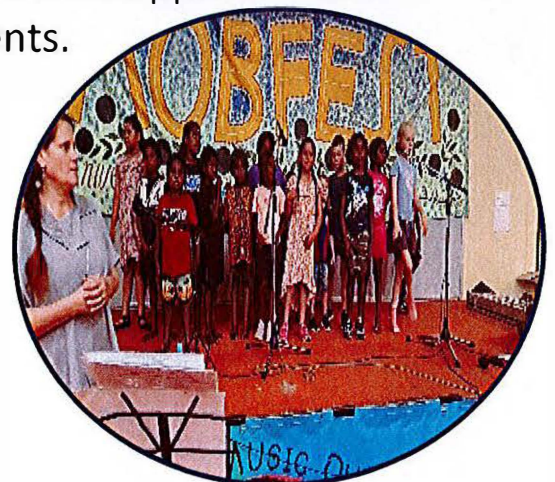
Focus on Whole School Wellbeing program. Support to engage students who feel vulnerable.
