2. Calculations are based on precise data, due to rounding some totals may not correspond with the sum of separate figures.

3. Ungraded students are in an interim year level until students can be assessed and assigned to a year level. Where a student is recorded against an ungraded year level, it is often for a very short time period within a term. This may make data appear erroneous. For example: a student enrolled in Ungraded Primary for 1 week out of the 8 week reporting period will have a rounded enrolment of 0 in Ungraded Primary, but their attendance rate for that 1 week will be recorded against Ungraded Primary, e.g. 45 per cent.
