### GTNT Group School-Based Apprentice or Trainee Award

Criteria
<p>The nomination form must be completed by the applicant.</p> <p>Ensure all criteria are addressed.</p> <p>Ensure supporting evidence is provided.</p> <p>Candidates will be assessed on the strength of the written nomination form.</p> <p>Any other relevant information which shows the quality of the apprentice or trainee may be provided.</p>

### Guidance Points

Criteria	Points for guidance in writing nomination
Demonstrated high quality performance on the job	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skill Development (the rapid development of competencies, the level of skill attained; additional skills developed and translation of skills attained off the job into the workplace).</li> <li>• Knowledge of employer/host employer's business</li> <li>• Awareness and understanding of new developments and trends in apprentice/trainee's workplace or industry</li> <li>• Overall work performance and commitment to the apprenticeship or traineeship.</li> <li>• demonstrated commitment to safe work practices.</li> </ul>
Off and on the job training achievements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• RTO/School results e.g. effective written and oral communication</li> <li>• Team work and leadership e.g. self-started projects and team participation</li> <li>• Goal setting and planning e.g. work involving goal setting and attainment</li> <li>• Self-reliance e.g. ability to manage skills and personal development</li> </ul>
Statement of Claim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Career goals and aspirations</li> </ul>
Northern Territory Certificate of Education and Training (NTCET) completer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be an NTCET completer in the award year.</li> </ul>
