

2019 VET DELIVERED TO SECONDARY STUDENTS

INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS AND RTO'S

INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

Each year schools apply to the Department of Education to fund VET programs for their students to access. Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) are funded based on nominal hours and the industry rate that the Department of Trade, Business and Innovation specifies.

It is strongly advised that schools discuss their VET application with the RTOs that they wish to engage with, prior to submitting the form.

Schools need to submit their 2019 VET Application by Friday 22nd June 2018.

All middle and senior schools are eligible to apply for VET.

If an RTO does not offer the required VET course as part of their funded allocation, schools can pay RTO's directly out of their global budgets. This is called a 'fee for service' delivery.

All RTOs providing a service in an urban setting will be subject to cluster arrangements. This means that all urban school students will have access to the urban funded program. RTOs will advise on the enrolment process.

Middle school students who are progressing into senior school in 2019, should discuss their VET preferences with the VET Coordinator of the senior school that they will be attending.

INFORMATION FOR REGISTERED TRAINING ORGANISATIONS

RTO's are advised to market their courses to schools from April through to June and if possible, attend school information and subject selection nights.

The Department of Education's Industry Engagement and Employment Pathways (IEEP) work unit sends out the VET Course Application forms to all middle and senior schools in May. The schools submit their application, which details the VET courses they prefer and the RTO provider.

If an RTO is funded by the Department of Education, a notification email is sent to the RTO advising them of the funding offer. If the RTO accepts the offer, a resource agreement is sent out for signing.
