

Privacy information statement – Baggin’ the Dragon

What is a Privacy information statement?

When a digital service or application is utilised as part of the teaching and learning curriculum, schools require your consent to allow collection, use and disclosure of your child’s personal information including when data is transferred and held in cloud-based storage offshore, outside Australia. The following Privacy information statement provides information about the application to allow informed consent to be provided.

What is Baggin’ the Dragon?

Baggin’ the Dragon is an online maths programme that help students to build solid maths foundations with the aim to transform each student into a mathematical thinker and problem solver. Through interactive maths questions and learning strategies that covers 90% of the maths curriculum, this online programme is suitable for ages 5 to 15 years and beyond allowing students to progress at their own pace.

What data is collected?

Teachers register an account using their name class and school. Each student is linked to the teacher and class account using their name and class and year level.

How is the data used?

Student information collected is used to set up each individual student account linked to the school class account for use of this application. Results are displayed by class not individual students.

Is the data secure?

Baggin’ the Dragon is one of the EdAlive online learning programs, that has been assessed and qualified to be part of the Safer Technologies 4 Schools. This application is KidSafe certified.

Who has access to the data?

School staff who are administrators have overall access of the school’s account, and each classroom teacher manages their own class and linked students. Employees of EdAlive must have their Australian state’s Working with Childrens Clearance and a National Police Check. EdAlive

state they do not share any personal information with any third parties within Australia or overseas.

When is the data deleted?

Teacher administrators of a school account can edit modify or delete student data as required. Any other concerns relating to the management of personal information can be directed to the EdAlive privacy officer via their website.

Where is the data?

Data is hosted outside of the Northern Territory but within Australia via Amazon Web Services.
